# TEIIILLIM (PSALMS): READINGS IN BIBLICAL POETRY

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

In-depth analysis of selected psalms with special attention to genre, literary style, historical setting and expressions of religious sentiment. Major trends in modern scholarship: the historical approach; form-criticism; modern literary methods.

#### REQUIREMENTS

Preparation of sources and readings on the syllabus *prior* to each class, before which a short quiz will be given. Familiarity with studies and commentaries in the bibliography below, pp. 4-5. Final examination (class fifteen). Research paper (15-20 pages) on a topic chosen in consultation with the professor. Please bring a  $\pi cmr$  (without English) to each class.
